

Qatar Olympic Committee Awards JTC For Al Khor Horse Owner's **Complex Project**

Qatar Olympic Committee Awards JTC For Al Khor Horse Owner's Complex Project

atar Olympic Committee (QOC) officially awarded to Al Jaber Trading & Contracting Co. W.L.L the Horse Owner's Complex project located on Al Shamal road in the vicinity Al- Khor last 25th June 2014. The Project comprises the Horse training facility which includes indoor and outdoor training areas and support services and infrastructure.

Based on the received letter of acceptance signed by chairman of small tender & auctions committee of QOC, the contract value is Three Hundred and Eighty Millions, Qatari Riyals (380,000,000.00) only. The project whole duration is 730 calendar days with a tentative start date of 3rd August 2014.

Project Overview:

The project completion is divided into two Important Milestones:

Milestone 1 includes the completion of horse track including all MEP works associated with horse track by the 29 April 2015. It should be separated from the work site after construction and integrated with phase 1.

Milestone 2 comprises to complete all other remaining works by the 08 August 2016

This involves Construction, Completion and Maintenance of the following Buildings:

- Administration building- 3Nos.
- Swimming Pool- 3 Nos.




Part of Plan Layout for Phase2
